

AMENDMENT TO S. CON. RES. 3
OFFERED BY MR. POCAN OF WISCONSIN

At the end of the concurrent resolution, add the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . POINT OF ORDER AGAINST LEGISLATION THAT**
2 **WOULD BREAK DONALD TRUMP'S PROMISE**
3 **NOT TO CUT SOCIAL SECURITY, MEDICARE,**
4 **OR MEDICAID.**

5 (a) POINT OF ORDER.—It shall not be in order in
6 the House of Representatives or the Senate to consider
7 any bill, joint resolution, motion, amendment, amendment
8 between the Houses, or conference report that would—

9 (1) result in a reduction of guaranteed benefits
10 scheduled under title II of the Social Security Act
11 (42 U.S.C. 401 et seq.);

12 (2) increase either the early or full retirement
13 age for the benefits described in paragraph (1);

14 (3) privatize Social Security;

15 (4) result in a reduction of guaranteed benefits
16 for individuals entitled to, or enrolled for, benefits
17 under the Medicare program under title XVIII of
18 such Act (42 U.S.C. 1395 et seq.); or

1 (5) result in a reduction of benefits or eligibility
2 for individuals enrolled in, or eligible to receive med-
3 ical assistance through, a State Medicaid plan or
4 waiver under title XIX of such Act (42 U.S.C. 1396
5 et seq.).

6 (b) WAIVER AND APPEAL IN THE SENATE.—Sub-
7 section (a) may be waived or suspended in the Senate only
8 by an affirmative vote of three-fifths of the Members, duly
9 chosen and sworn. An affirmative vote of three-fifths of
10 the Members of the Senate, duly chosen and sworn, shall
11 be required to sustain an appeal of the ruling of the Chair
12 on a point of order raised under subsection (a).

13 (c) WAIVER IN THE HOUSE.—It shall not be in order
14 in the House of Representatives to consider a rule or order
15 that waives the application of subsection (a). As disposi-
16 tion of a point of order under this subsection, the Chair
17 shall put the question of consideration with respect to the
18 rule or order, as applicable. The question of consideration
19 shall be debatable for 10 minutes by the Member initiating
20 the point of order and for 10 minutes by an opponent,
21 but shall otherwise be decided without intervening motion
22 except one that the House adjourn.
